ELECTRICAL CEUs OFFERED AT NORTHWEST IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Northwest Iowa Community College, Sheldon, Iowa will offer an electrical course entitled Maintaining Reliability of Power Distribution Systems starting on Tuesday, October 9 and finishing the following evening on October 10, 2012. The course will be held from 6:30pm to 9:30pm in building H, room 513 on the NCC campus.

This seminar will focus on the core concepts of sustaining reliability of a typical low voltage power distribution system within a manufacturing facility. The main focus of discussion will be on power quality troubleshooting and measurements as well as conducting site surveys; however other important concepts such as electrical safety, recommended preventative maintenance, and basic power system analysis will be discussed to provide the attendees with a more holistic understanding of power distribution systems reliability.

The instructor for this class is Brian Seligman and the fee is \$75. This course is approved for 6 Iowa electrical non-code CEHs.
