### **FREE! TAX HELP**

#### Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Site

The Northwest Iowa Community College, Sheldon, Iowa, Accounting Program Students will be doing free federal and state tax e-filing this year. Students will help prepare basic tax returns for people with low and limited income, individuals with disabilities, non-English speaking, and elderly taxpayers. Low and limited income is defined by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) as \$49,000 per household. Appointments can be made Fridays: January 22 and 29; February 5, 12, 19, and 26; March 19 and 26 from 10:10 a.m. to 2:10 p.m. Remember there is no charge for this service.

The IRS will **NOT** allow us to file:

- Schedule C – Profit or Loss from Business
- Complicated and Advanced Schedule D – Capital Gains and Losses
- Schedule E – Rent and Royalties
- Form SS-5 – Request for Social Security Number
- Form 2106 – Employee Business Expense
- Form 3903 – Moving
- Form 8606 – Nondeductible IRA
- Form 8615 – Minor's Investment Income
