NORTHWEST IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO HOST FAFSA HELP NIGHT

Northwest Iowa Community College, in collaboration with Iowa College Goal Sunday partners, will be providing free, on-site assistance to students and families interested in applying for financial aid. The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is required for federal and state financial aid programs. Completing and filing the FAFSA is the first and most important step for students seeking financial aid for college.

NCC will host its FAFSA Help Night on Monday, February 24, from 4:00pm-6:30pm in Building B, Room 204 on the NCC campus. Financial aid professionals and volunteers will be available to help with:

- Completing and filing the FAFSA
- Scholarship information
- The financial aid process and what to expect next

This assistance is offered to all students and their families regardless of where they plan to attend college. While some people may not have filed their taxes by this time, they may come, ask questions, and learn how to complete their FAFSA at a later date.
