Maintaining Your Windows Computer Class Offered at Northwest Iowa Community College

Learn the basics of keeping your Windows 7 and Windows 8 computer running at its best. Topics covered include: hard drive cleanup and optimization, removal of unwanted software, updating/patching of Windows, configuring your antivirus software and options on how to back up the files on your computer.
