MOPED SAFETY COURSES TO BE OFFERED AT NORTHWEST IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Northwest Iowa Community College, Sheldon, Iowa, will be offering “Moped Safety” courses throughout the spring and summer months. The courses will be offered on the following Saturdays, March 20 (#18566) April 17 (#18567), May 15 (#18568) and August 28 (#18571). Classes will also be held on Tuesday, June 8 (#18569) and on Thursday, July 8 (#18570). All classes will meet from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Prepayment and pre-registration are required for Moped classes. Participants should bring a sack lunch with them when they attend the class.

Minimum age for course participation is age thirteen (13). Fourteen and fifteen-year-old Iowans are required by law to complete a six-hour education course prior to being issued a license to operate a motorized bicycle (moped) on public highways.
