Sanford Sheldon, Northwest Iowa Community College Partner for Free CNA Training

Sanford Sheldon Medical Center has partnered with Northwest Iowa Community College to offer free Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) training and a conditional employment offer with Sanford Sheldon. An informational meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 29 at 7 p.m. at Sanford Sheldon Medical Center, Lower Level, HR Suite.

The CNA classes are designed to prepare students to better understand the knowledge and skills needed to care for residents in long-term care facilities. This course involves 75 hours of training including 30 hours of classroom instruction, 15 hours lab training and 30 hours of clinical experience.

Upon successful completion of the training, students will be working at Sanford Sheldon's long-term care facility. As a nonprofit organization, Sanford Sheldon's focus is on those we serve. "We are excited about this opportunity to collaborate with Northwest Iowa Community College and help educate members of our community in the rewarding career of a Certified Nurse Assistant," said Dianne Wolthuizen, Human Resources Coordinator at Sanford Sheldon Medical Center.
