Northwest Iowa Community College Welcomes Dr. Alethea Stubbe as the 9th President and will hold Ribbon Cutting Ceremonies at the Northwest Iowa Lifelong Learning & Recreation Center

On Friday, September 2nd, from 9:30am-11am Northwest Iowa Community College will host a Chamber Coffee to welcome Dr. Alethea Stubbe as NCC's ninth President followed by ribbon cutting ceremonies for the new Northwest Iowa Lifelong Learning & Recreation Center (LLRC).

The Chamber Coffee starts at 9:30am with comments from Leroy Van Kekerix, President of NCC's Board of Trustees, and Dr. Stubbe at 10:00am followed by the ribbon cutting of the LLRC at 10:30am. The public is invited to attend the welcome and ribbon cutting ceremonies and tour the new facility.

Dr. Stubbe succeeds Dr. William Giddings who retired May 13. Stubbe is the first female to hold the position and was Vice President of Education and Learning Services at NCC, a position she held since 2007. Prior to that, she was Vice President of Finance & Administrative Services from 2003 to 2007 and Administrative Secretarial Program Instructor from 1991 to 2003 at Northwest Iowa Community College. Stubbe holds an undergraduate degree in Accounting/Business Economics/Secondary Education from Northwestern College in Orange City, a master's degree in Business Administration from University of South Dakota in Vermillion, and a doctorate in Educational Leadership from Iowa State University in Ames.

Van Kekerix, "The Board is honored to have Dr. Stubbe as the next President of Northwest Iowa Community College. She has demonstrated her leadership skills in her different positions at NCC and her experience in leading the business office as well as the Chief Academic Officer serves her well for the President's position."

The LLRC is a 34,795 square foot facility that includes a college-regulation multipurpose gymnasium, walking/running track, fitness facility, bath/locker facilities, seminar rooms, office space, reception area, and convention trade show area.

The ribbon cutting ceremonies are to celebrate the grand opening of the LLRC. "Through innovative and collaborative efforts between Northwest Iowa Community College, the City of Sheldon, Sanford Sheldon and along with many other Northwest Iowa partners we have constructed a facility that will meet the wellness needs of residents of Northwest Iowa" Stated Dr. Stubbe.
