Spanish for Nursing Class Offered at Northwest Iowa Community College

The **Spanish for Nursing** program prepares non-Spanish-speaking nurses to provide medical care and attention to Spanish-speaking patients in medical office settings and in hospitals. In addition to workplace Spanish language, this program provides trans-cultural training for nurses and future nurses. Emphasis is placed on enhancing quality of patient care. No prior knowledge of Spanish is necessary. 1.5 CEUs for Nurses/ 15 CEHs for Social Work, Direct Caregivers.
