### **Northwest Iowa Community College a Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Site for the 10<sup>th</sup> Year**

Northwest Iowa Community College, Sheldon, IA, for the 10<sup>th</sup> year in a row is working with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) as a Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) site. Accounting program students past and present, Administrative Secretarial program students and Health Information Technology students are working together to provide free income tax filing assistance for basic tax returns for people with low and limited income, individuals with disabilities, non-English speaking, and elderly taxpayers. Low and limited income is defined by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) as \$49,000 per household.
