WELDING NIGHT CLASS OFFERED AT NORTHWEST IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Northwest Iowa Community College, Sheldon, IA, will offer a course in basic welding starting Tuesday, April 5, 2011. This 30-hour course meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m., in room 424, Building D, at NCC.

Participants will learn about all major welding and cutting processes used in production and repair, in addition to information on reading welding symbols, inspecting and testing welds, and getting a job in the welding industry. There will be plenty of lab time to practice one or more of the welding processes most widely used in industry today, including: oxyfuel gas welding and cutting, shielded metal arc welding, gas metal arc welding, flux cored arc welding, and gas tungsten arc welding, or you may choose to specialize in preparation for welder qualification.
