“BEGINNING WOODWORKING” CLASS TO BE OFFERED AT NORTHWEST IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Northwest Iowa Community College will offer a five-session “Beginning Woodworking” class beginning on Wednesday, October 2 through October 30, 2013. The class will meet from 5:30 - 9:30 p.m. in Room 319 of Building C. Experience the joy and satisfaction of creating a wood project. Students will learn to use hand and power tools efficiently and safely. One of five projects will be chosen by the beginning student which will enable the student to build a useful item of wood while learning how to select proper materials, use appropriate equipment, cut, fit, assemble, and finish the project. Projects that the student can build include: Adirondack chair, Shaker table, checkerboard, bookshelf, or quilt rack. Cost of materials is in addition to the cost of the class.
