Five-year average credentialing examination (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography exam) pass rate of not less than 75% for the first attempt within six months of graduation.

*Final data for 2016 reflects that 7 of 8 graduates succeeded in passing the examination.

Five-year average job placement rate of not less than 75% within twelve months of graduation.

Job placement rate varies based on the number of graduates “actively seeking” employment.

The JRCERT has defined “not actively seeking employment” as:

1. Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts **OR**
2. Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation **OR**
3. Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours **OR**
4. Graduate is on active military duty **OR**
5. Graduate is continuing education.
