Admission Checklist

1. Submit application for admission in the Pre Radiologic Technology program
2. Submit high school and all college transcripts
3. Complete Entrance Assessment
English Comprehension and Basic Math Skills

Option I: ACT/Required Scores of Math=17, English=17

Option II: EdReady(NCC Assessment)/Required Scores of Math=85, English=85)

4. Complete the pre-requisite courses: Anatomy & Physiology I, Introduction to Psychology and Certified Nurse Aid (CNA)-final grade of C or higher

Priority Admission into the program will be determined by February 1st. All applicants after February 1st who complete the admission criteria will be considered for admission per available seats.

An admission interview conducted by the Faculty of the Radiologic Technology Department may be requested.
